**A BILL**

To prohibit the Secretary of State from issuing a passport, passport card, or Consular Report of Birth Abroad that includes the unspecified “X” gender designation, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Passport Sanity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION REGARDING CERTAIN GENDER DES-**  
2 **IGNATION ON PASSPORTS, PASSPORT CARDS,**  
3 **AND CONSULAR REPORTS OF BIRTH ABROAD**  
4 **ISSUED BY DEPARTMENT OF STATE.**

5 (a) **DEFINED TERM.**—In this section, the term “cov-  
6 ered document” means a passport, passport card, or Con-  
7 sular Report of Birth Abroad issued by the Department  
8 of State.

9 (b) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of State shall—

10 (1) ensure each application for a covered docu-  
11 ment only includes the gender designation male or  
12 female; and

13 (2) prohibit the issuance of a covered document  
14 that includes the unspecified “X” gender designa-  
15 tion.
