1	(1) COVID–19 VACCINE MANDATE.—The term
2	"COVID–19 vaccine mandate" means—
3	(A) any requirement that a person (other
4	than a Federal employee or an individual per-
5	forming work on or in connection with a con-
6	tract with the Federal Government) receive a
7	COVID-19 vaccine, including a requirement
8	that such a person either receive such a vaccine
9	or be subject to COVID-19 testing; or
10	(B) any requirement that an employer re-
11	quire an employee or independent contractor to
12	receive a COVID–19 vaccine, including by re-
13	quiring such employee or independent con-
14	tractor to either receive such vaccine or be sub-
15	ject to COVID–19 testing.
16	(2) EMPLOYER.—The term "employer" means
17	a person engaged in a business affecting commerce
18	who has employees or independent contractors. Such
19	term includes a State or political subdivision of a
20	State but does not include the United States.
