6 (a) IN GENERAL.—On and after the date of the en7 actment of this Act, the waiver determination issued by
8 the Secretary of State pursuant the provisions of law spec9 ified in subsection (b) and submitted to Congress on Sep10 tember 11, 2023, shall have no force or effect.

(b) PROVISIONS OF LAW SPECIFIED.—The provisions 1 2 of law specified in this subsection are— 3 (1) section 1245(d)(5) of the National Defense 4 Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2012 (22 U.S.C. 5 8513a(d)(5); or (2) section 1244(i) or 1247(f) of the Iran Free-6 dom and Counter-Proliferation Act of 2012 (22) 7 8 U.S.C. 8803(i) and 8806(f)).
